**We're delighted that you've joined us for DT Philly! Now that you've told us a little about yourselves, get to know us by completing this scavenger hunt. Be sure to take full advantage of your resources and materials throughout the program.**

1. Compete 360 is happy to help you at any time during your project. Find our email address on the website and send us a message with the subject line, "This is what dreams are made of," so we know you can reach us if you need us.
2. We made a 3D puzzle for you! What is it and how do you earn pieces of it?
3. We gave you a kit that contains special activities and program supplies. What is one thing you see in your activity kit that interests you?
4. We have experts—professional designers—who can consult with you on your project. Who in the Designer Directory seems like someone you'd be comfortable contacting for help during your project?
5. The badges you earn for completing inspiration activities honor creative people or companies and come with a story that connects to the current stage of your design work. Where can you find the badge stories, and what is the first name of Mr. Ando (Define Stage badge honoree)?
6. Your teacher has a DT Philly Playbook (and there's another one in your activity kit). The playbook helps you understand what to do in each step of the design process, shares examples of how to do your project work, and contains other resources. In the Prototype stage there are photos of a project done by a former DT Philly team. What do those photo show?
7. Compete 360 sends you feedback every time you submit work. You don't have any feedback yet, but to show you how to find it, we've hidden a riddle in the feedback section for an assignment on your team page. Find the riddle and tell us what you think the answer is.
8. We created a series of videos for you. These videos explain what design thinking is and give you an overview of each stage of your project work. The videos also give you an example of how to use design thinking to solve a problem. What problem is the design team in your video series trying to solve?
9. From time to time, notices from Compete 360 and comments from other teams will show up on your team page. Keep an eye out for these and be sure to read them throughout DT Philly! What currently appears in your Notices box and Comments box?
